

Azaan International School re-opens for senior classes

Regular offline teaching commenced at Azaan International School today for grades IX-XII in compliance with the memo from the Department of School Education, Govt. of Telangana.

Wearing face masks and maintaining the distance from each other, students seemed to be happy to return back to school after the prolonged period of online teaching due to the pandemic.



When asked about the preparation done by the school for reopening, Correspondent of the school, Dr. Nayyer Farozan said that the SOPs conveyed by the Education Department are being strictly followed. She explained that the campus has been thoroughly cleaned and sanitization will be done on daily basis.

Infrared thermometers have been provided and security staff has been trained to check the

temperature. Body temperature of all the staff and the students will be checked before they enter the campus.

To reduce the class strength, each section has been divided into two subsections and thus the school will be running in two shifts.

Sanitization and medical teams have been formed as per the guidelines.

Apart from the medical room, isolation room has also been earmarked in case of need.

Teachers have been briefed about the measures and given seating plans which are to be strictly followed to ensure social distancing.

The school has conducted Parent-Teacher meetings during the week to inform the parents about the commencement of classes and to obtain written consent from them. Almost all the parents who attended the meetings have given the consent acknowledging the importance of regular classes especially for the preparation of the forthcoming Board Examinations said the Correspondent.

Dr. Mohammed Yosuf Azam, Chairman of the School conveyed his best wishes for the students and the staff and requested the parents to follow the given guidelines and to pray to Almighty for protection from all calamities.
