We add **-ed** to for the **simple past tense**. But sometimes, the spellings of certain verbs are different when we change them from the simple present tense to the simple past tense.

\*buy- bought

\*go- went

\*draw- drew

\*catch- caught

\*fight- fought

We can use the simple present tense and the simple past in the negative form.

**Simple present tense- do/does+not+base form of the verb**

**Simple past tense- did+not+base form of the verb**
